



TRANSPORT REGULATIONS winter season from 27. November 2025

for regular buses in the Paznaun Valley

Winter sports between Landeck railway station and Galtür Wirl:

1. Winter sports enthusiasts can use lines 260 and 298 free of charge.

WINTER SPORTS ENTHUSIAST are:

- Skiers and snowboarders with appropriate winter sports equipment
- Tobogganers with appropriate winter sports equipment
- Cross-country skiers with appropriate winter sports equipment
- Persons with winter sports clothing and a ski pass for travel to a mountain railway
- The Regio Card or Tirol Ski Tickets are also valid as ski passes, but only for the purpose of practising winter sports in Paznaun.
- 2. Guests of the Paznaun-Ischgl Tourist Association all year round along the entire route Persons with a guest card issued in their name during the duration of their stay Children accompanied by their parents up to the age of 15.

Persons with an arrival voucher on the day of arrival

Guests are not considered owners of a holiday home, even if they have a guest card.

Dog transportation:

- Dogs wearing a bite-proof muzzle may be transported free of charge if they can be accommodated without disturbing or obstructing other passengers.
- 2. Small dogs must be carried, large dogs must be kept on a short leash.
- 3. Passengers must supervise their animals. They may not be transported on seats. If the bus is full, the driver may refuse to allow them to travel.
